



## IUU FISHING ACTIVITY

**RESOLUTION 07/01**

TO PROMOTE COMPLIANCE BY NATIONALS OF CONTRACTING PARTIES AND COOPERATING NON-CONTRACTING PARTIES WITH IOTC CONSERVATION AND MANAGEMENT MEASURES

APPLICABLE TO



This Resolution aims to enhance cooperation between CPCs by facilitating measures taken against their nationals (natural or legal persons subject to their jurisdiction) who have engaged in IUU fishing activities. It is without prejudice to - and complements - the primary responsibility of flag States to control their vessels and applies to all CPCs.

**REPORTING REQUIREMENTS**

This Resolution establishes a single event-based reporting requirement, relating to actions and measures taken on natural or legal persons.

CPC ALL STATES

**WHAT**

Submit report on actions and measures taken against natural or legal persons involved in IUU fishing activities

**WHEN****DEADLINES**

*Any time (event-based reporting)*

# REPORTING REQUIREMENTS: FORMAT AND CONTENT

This Resolution requires CPCs to investigate allegations or reports concerning the involvement of any persons subject to their jurisdiction in IUU fishing activities, take action in response to any verified activity and report on their actions.

## REPORTING REQUIREMENT 1:

SUBMIT REPORTS ON ACTIONS AND MEASURES TAKEN UNDER THIS RESOLUTION, AGAINST NATURAL OR LEGAL PERSONS INVOLVED IN IUU ACTIVITIES. (PARA 2)

### IMPLEMENTATION

- How to report: There is no set template to report information on cases and measures taken. CPCs are encouraged to submit these reports in the form they deem fit, ensuring they cover the following items: (a) established IUU activities, and (b) sanctions against the offender(s).
- Reporting format: Ideally in MS Word or pdf file format.
- Where to send the information: The report should be sent to [iotc-secretariat@fao.org](mailto:iotc-secretariat@fao.org)

## COOPERATION REQUIREMENTS

CPCs are required to cooperate in the implementation of measures and actions taken in relation to the investigation of IUU fishing activities.
